

Tucson Cactus & Succulent Society (TCSS) Educational Outreach School Grant Program

Grant Proposal Requirements, Conditions, and Details

- 1) Proposal subject must pertain to and involve Cactus and other Succulents.
- 2) Proposal must be in writing, this form (both sides) plus one additional page max if needed.
- 3) Proposal must be mailed to: **Tucson Cactus & Succulent Society, School Grant Program, PO Box 64759, Tucson, AZ 85728-4759** or emailed to **Education@TucsonCactus.org**.
- 4) All teachers submitting proposals will be notified by Email as to status of request.
- 5) Grant if awarded, to be by check to applicant within 6 to 8 weeks after receipt.
- 6) The number of grants awarded will be a function of available TCSS funds.
- 7) Grant monies awarded may only be used for proposal as detailed and may not be used for salaries, wages, or compensation for time or other services unless specifically approved for such.
- 8) TCSS normally has Rescued Cactus (Barrels, Hedgehogs, Mamms, Cholla, Prickly Pear, Ocotillo, and small Saguaros) that can be purchased for approved projects. Costs to you are about \$6 to \$8 each.
- 9) TCSS requests a brief summary and photo of project success at the end of the project for grants awarded. Mail to address in item 3) above or email to **Education@TucsonCactus.org**.
