

How to Access Tucson Cactus and Succulent Society's (TCSS) Zoom Meeting

If you are using both the audio and video camera on a PC, Tablet or Smartphone, please use <https://bit.ly/tcssmm> (note: for easy remembering, the /tcssmm stands for **TCSS Monthly Meeting**). You can use this link for a PC or tablet with audio *only*.

Note: If you are uncomfortable with not knowing where you will be going with this link just add a plus sign (+) at the end of the link – <https://bit.ly/tcssmm+>. Then, click on the link shown that starts with **https://zoom.....** and you will be taken to the meeting.

Do I need to download the Zoom client? No, when you use the bit.ly address, you will be taken to a page – “Launch Meeting”, ignore the large text and click on the join link on the 3rd line (“If you cannot download or run the application, [join from your browser.](#)”) All one needs to do is to type in your name and click Join.

If you are on your cell phone with audio only, please call into one of the following numbers that is closest to you – if you are outside the US, please click on the link shown to find your nearest call-in number and enter the Meeting ID and Passcode when prompted (note: skip the prompt that asks for the Participant’s ID):
